1. What will the money be used for? (i.e., software, videos, etc.) Please see attached for allowable items.

Obtaining training DVDs for various Admin. of Justice classes on topics that are current in the field. (\$500-1000.)

And the purchase of U.S. Constitution booklets and Penal Codes for multiple classes. (\$500-1000)

Purchase of a limited no. of class texts from various courses to be put in the library reserve/resource section for students who cannot purchase texts. (\$1000)

Additional shelving on the walls of L-13A office for storage of equipment and supplies due to the critical lack of other storage options. (\$1000)

I have not been able to contact all instructors regarding their desires and needs for equipment and supplies so I believe this list would be enlarged. I would like to have a funding option for additional purchases.

2. How many students will benefit from this purchase?

Averaging 12 AOJ classes per quarter with 35-45 students per class = approx..500 per quarter.

3. How does this enhance your Equity Goals?

Additional training aids enhance the quality the academic value of each class. Students learn differently (audio/visual/hands on) and additional equipment and supplies addresses those varying learning styles. We, especially the AOJ program, draw students from the financially challenged and prepared communities. Several students do not have the funding to purchase class equipment/books above the normal text. Supplies (ex: Penal Codes) would give students access to resources they may not be able to purchase. I believe all of the above examples would enhance the programs critical goal of reducing, or even eliminating, the equity gap that currently affects students.

4. How does this enhance your Student Learning Outcomes?

Assists instructors in presenting information in the most effective manner and assists students in understanding concepts and retaining course material in a learning verses a memorization capability.

5. Was this noted on your Program Review?
