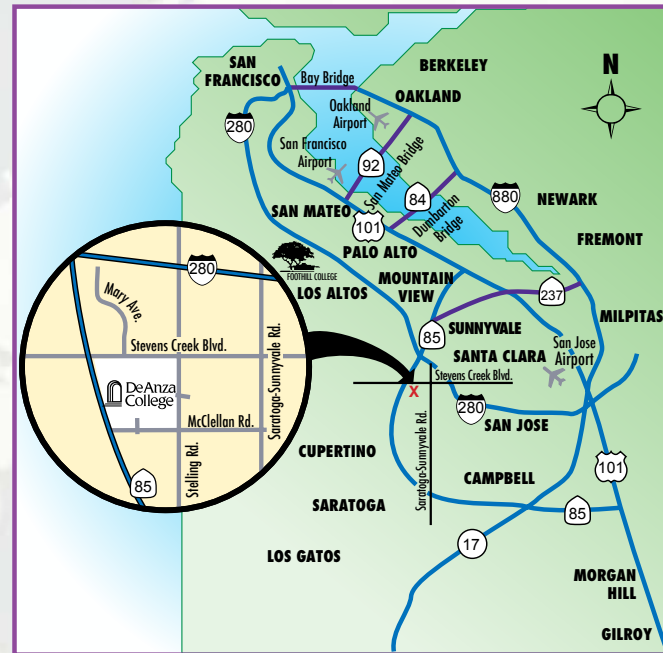




The De Anza Campus

De Anza College Intensive Summer ESL Course for International Students with a TOEFL score of 475-499

Program Dates: June 28 – August 19, 2010

This course is for you if...

- You plan to attend De Anza in Fall 2010
- Your iBT TOEFL score is between 52 and 60 (paper: between 475 and 499) or IELTS: 5.0

International students who want to attend De Anza but have not scored 61 on the iBT TOEFL (500 on paper-based test) or 5.5 on the IELTS will be admitted in Fall 2010 after successfully completing a summer ESL (English as a Second Language) preparatory course, **ESL 244**.

Advantages

- You will be admitted to De Anza after you have successfully completed **ESL 244**.
- You will NOT be required to retake the TOEFL.
- You will receive 10 units of credit.
- You will get an early start on your studies at De Anza and be better prepared for academic courses.
- You will participate in activities that will introduce you to the beautiful San Francisco Bay Area.

Application Deadline

April 30, 2010

Program Cost

- \$2,500 (U.S.) This includes all tuition, administrative fees, textbooks for the course, health insurance and scheduled activities. *This does not include housing, food or personal expenses.*
- A non-refundable deposit of \$500 is required with your application. The balance of \$2,000 is due by May 31, 2010. (Your deposit will be refunded if the U.S. Embassy denies your F-1 visa application with written proof.)

Housing

- Stay with carefully screened American Host Families
- Share in American family life
- Experience an enriching cultural environment

The International Student Placements arranges homestays. Home placement is strongly recommended for students who are studying abroad for the first time, and is required for students under 18 years of age. Homestay includes a private room (with a shared bathroom) and 2 meals a day.

- Two rate plans: (paid directly to family)
\$800 per month, includes 2 meals per day
- \$650 per month with no meals
- Homestay placement fee is \$435 (Make checks payable to International Student Placements)
- Download and submit homestay application directly to International Student Placements

Apartment Information

Since apartments in this area are quite expensive, students who choose to live in apartments usually share with others. One-bedroom apartments range from \$1,200 to \$1,500 per month. Shared apartments cost approximately \$700 per month.

Application Procedure

1. Submit a completed De Anza College International Student Application and all necessary documents for admission to the Fall Quarter 2010. Download an application at www.deanza.edu/international.
2. Students must have taken either TOEFL or IELTS.
 - TOEFL Scores (52-60 or 475-499)
 - IELTS Score (5.0)
3. Send a \$500 deposit to enroll in **ESL 244** for summer 2010. This deposit is separate from the \$50 application fee for admission to Fall Quarter 2010.
4. Mail all of the above to International Student Programs, De Anza College (see application for address).
