Course Outline: SLOs: Outcome 1: Investigate, evaluate, and differentiate between algebraic and transcendental functions in their graphic, formulaic, and tabular representations. Outcome 2: Synthesize, model, and communicate real-life applications and phenomena using algebraic and transcendental functions.
I shall cover chapters 1 to 3, partly chapter 10, and review Appendix A. 1 to A. 6 sections of the book. Topics are Functions and Graphs, Polynomial and Rational Functions, Exponential and Logarithmic Functions, It is an intensive course, requiring ten to fifteen hours of study time outside the class. We are going to use TI-83 plus graphing calculator intensively.
Homework: Students will do homework on internet using Enhanced WebAssign program at web address www.webassign.net/cengage. You need to get the access code when you purchase the book. WebAssign course name and class key are written above. You need class key when you create your account. Late homework will not be accepted for grading purpose.
Examinations: There will be three midterm tests each of one hour, and three quizzes each of 15-20 minutes. There will be no make-ups for missed tests/final or quizzes. If only one test is missed due to unavoidable circumstance, and the instructor is notified in advance or quickly; the final exam score $\%$ will be used to replace score of missed test. A comprehensive final examination of two hours will be given during 1:45 to 3:45 p.m. on Tuesday, June 27, 2017 in our classroom. Student absents in the final exam will get $\mathbf{F}$ grade.
